-Once we receive a referral, we contact home.

-With your signed consent, information is gathered from classes to determine how your child is doing.

-The WVW SAP team will then work with you to develop a plan of action that will help your child achieve success.

-As a parent/guardian, your input is important to finding the right resources for your child. However, participation is not mandatory.
