MISSION STATEMENT

Wyoming Valley West Community:

The following is the Wyoming Valley West School District's Continuity of Education Plan (CEP) for Remediation and Review to commence Tuesday, March 31, 2020.

The Continuity of Education Plan (CEP) plan is a fluid and potentially changing plan. The district will move forward each week in increments to engage students while we are following the recommendations of our Governor to stay home. It involves two to five hours per day of meaningful enrichment, review, and remediation driven by web-based means, including Google Classroom, Compass Learning, Skyward, and a number of other educational resources/links. The intent of this activity is to work for student mastery and depth of skills and concepts already introduced in the traditional education setting prior to implementation of this plan.

To be clear, the following current guidelines have been communicated to administration, faculty and staff:

- Students are currently not mandated to participate.
- Enrichment, remediation, and review assignments will not be graded.
- Attendance for students will not be taken.

Teachers will post daily and respond to student questions and contacts as they arise. The direction of assistance is limited to the content material the teacher has sent, and some limitations will occur. At present, teachers have been directed to refrain from utilizing audio and video live formats such as Zoom to deliver the enrichment, remediation, and review of material. Zoom (voice only) will be utilized for IEP and multidisciplinary team meetings as required for compliance with educational guidelines.
